- 908** Very neat and classic O scale two rail Pennsylvania GG-1. Loco was built by Tom Bedell as Baldwin Model Loco Works. Pittman 9515 motors installed. Owner states that this loco has been used to pull 75+ cars. Probably built in the late 1930's to early 1940's. Loco is C7 with some repaired paint chips.
- 909** Postwar Lionel O gauge 2554 Craig Manor Canadian Pacific illuminated Pullman passenger coach in original box, C6 with clean chassis and original stripes. Box has mild wear, tears, repairs, hole 1-1/2 x 1/2.
- 910** O scale two rail CLW 4-8-4 Northern steam locomotive. Pittman 9414 motor and NWSL universals installed. MRC 321 decoder also installed. Loco is C7-8, paint chipping around front truck and cylinder.
- 911** Postwar Lionel O gauge 726 steam locomotive with 2426W whistle tender. Loco has the Atomic Precision motor and tender frame has two dots of rust and could use new rollers. Trains are nicer C6+ area.
- 912** O scale two rail brass 4-6-2 steam locomotive. Loco has a DCC decoder installed. Loco is C7 condition with some paint chipping and shallow dents in the cab roof.
- 913** Postwar Lionel O gauge 671 steam locomotive with 2671W Pennsylvania tender with whistle (hairline at rear screw), trains should clean C7 area.
- 914** O scale two rail Milwaukee Road Hiawatha passenger cars. Five cars include two coaches, REA baggage, REA/RPO combo, and combo car. Very nice detailed interiors. Car bodies appear to be aluminum sides with wood frames. Cars are C7-8. A few loose windows in the cars.
- 915** Postwar Lionel O gauge 2531 Silver Dawn observation, 2532 Silver Range vista-dome, and 2533 Silver Cloud (missing a Silver Cloud plate) Pullman coach, illuminated aluminum passenger cars with matching dot head rivet stick-on name plates. Observation car is missing observation end parts, and all cars have a very small amount of light surface rust starting to form on chassis, otherwise C6 area.
- 916** Interesting O scale two rail electric B-2 box cab loco. Loco is thought to have been made by Tom Bedel. No pantographs. C6-7. See photos for best description.
- 917** Postwar Lionel O gauge 773LTS in Master Carton with inner boxes and original instructions sheet for loco. Tender has super tight hairline at front screw and loco has detached whistle trim, otherwise trains should clean C8 area. Loco box has insert. Loco and tender boxes look C8-9. Master Carton has rodent damage to a corner/edge, otherwise it is clean, very square, very solid with no missing flaps.
