


- 2001 Lionel prewar standard gauge 516 red hopper with gold rubber-stamped capacity data stamping, coal load, brass trim, black lettered brass plates and nickel journals in OB. Except for a couple of minor nicks, the hopper is C8. The OB is missing one interior flap and has tape repair. Frank Petruzzo was well known for his long string of coal hoppers and we felt it was appropriate to start off the auction with one of his hoppers.
- 2002 Lionel prewar standard gauge 137 Lioneltown station with dark cream base, white walls and chimneys, red roof, 45N green door and window frames, cream door and window inserts and nickel plates in OB. Except for a couple of minor nicks the station is C8. The OB has all flaps attached with label intact.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge red passenger set no. 360E, circa 1931-32 in OBs including; 8E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 332 baggage, 337 Pullman and a 338 observation. The cars have cream inserts and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled. The set is C7. The loco OB is missing end flaps and is taped on one end. The car boxes have all flaps attached.
- 2004 Lionel prewar 76 warning bell and shack with red base, Hiawatha orange roof, aluminum painted post with black bell, diecast sign and nickel finial in OB. Shack is C7. The OB has all flaps attached with label intact.
- 2005 Lionel prewar standard gauge peacock passenger set no. 352E, circa 1928-30 in individual OBs and set box including; 10E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 332 baggage with red doors, 339 Pullman and a 341 observation. The cars have orange inserts and nickel journals. The loco roof has one dent on the corner and loco has been rewheeled. The set is C6-7. The loco OB is missing one interior flap all other individual boxes have all flaps attached. Set box has no split corners and both labels are intact.
- 2006 Lionel prewar standard gauge 155 illuminated freight shed with white base, red floor, aluminum posts, gray roof trimmed in red, nickel finials and brass plate in OB, C6. The OB is missing two interior flaps.
- 2007 Lionel prewar standard gauge 163 freight station set with two 157 red hand trucks, 161 45N green baggage truck and a 162 dump truck with orange frame and blue bin in yellow OB with orange label, C7. The yellow OB has no split corners and label is intact.
- 2008 Lionel prewar standard gauge 408E apple green electric loco with red lettered brass plates in OB with original cardboard insert. The loco has been rewheeled and is C8. The OB is missing one interior flap and has tape repair. This OB is the version with the paste on label.
- 2009 Lionel prewar standard gauge 436 power station with gray base, terra cotta walls, mustard cornice, dark green window and door frames, pea green window inserts and skylight, maroon doors, Mojave chimney base, red chimney and brass plates. Station is C7-8.
- 2010 Lionel prewar standard gauge passenger set no. 362, circa 1931 in individual OBs and set box. The set contains a 384 black steam loco with brass and copper trim and green stripe, 384T tender with nickel journals, brass trim and green stripe, 309 maroon Pullman with terra cotta roof, cream inserts, wood grain doors, nickel journals and NEW YORK CENTRAL LINES stamped above the windows and a 312 maroon observation with terra cotta roof, cream inserts and doors, copper journals and THE LIONEL LINES stamped above the windows. Set is C7. The car and set boxes are correctly stamped WINE/IVORY and the 309 box is correctly stamped 319. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert. All individual OBs have all flaps attached. The set box has three split corners and has both labels fully intact. This is an unusual set with a strange combination of individual components.
- 2011 Lionel prewar standard gauge six no. 60 telegraph posts with gray posts, maroon cross arms, clear insulators and brass finials all in OBs, C8. The OBs are complete with most all flaps, some are detached.
- 2012 Lionel prewar standard gauge very scarce gray Sears passenger set no. 5185 in set box that has the original Lionel 352 number above the 5185. the set contains a 10E electric loco with dark green frame and red lettered brass plates, two 339 Pullmans and a 341 observation. The cars have maroon inserts and nickel journals. The loco is C6 and the cars are C6-7. The set box has original cardboard dividers, two split corners and shows wear.



- 2013 Lionel prewar standard gauge 435 power station with gray base, cream walls, terra cotta roof cornices, pea green skylight and window frames, dark green door frames, orange window inserts, red doors and chimney, Mojave chimney base and brass plates in OB. The power station is C6-7. The OB is complete with all flaps and has label fully intact.
- 2014 Lionel prewar standard gauge 8 maroon electric loco with cream stripe and inserts, super motor and black lettered brass plates in OB. The loco has been rewheeled and is C7. The box is complete with all flaps.
- 2015 Lionel prewar standard gauge 390E two-tone green steam loco and 390T tender in OBs. This is the scarce version with apple green stripes on both the loco and tender. The loco has brass and copper trim and the tender has brass trim and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled and is C6-7. The tender is C6. The OBs have all flaps attached.
- 2016 Lionel prewar standard gauge 92 floodlight tower with red base, aluminum tower, nickel lamp housings and plates in OB, C7-8. Box has all flaps attached and label is fully intact.
- 2017 Lionel prewar standard gauge 92 floodlight tower with terra cotta base, pea green tower, brass lamp housings and plates in OB. Except for a couple tiny nicks on the base, tower is C8. The OB has all flaps attached.
- 2018 Lionel prewar standard gauge Mojave passenger set no. 403E in individual worn OBs including; 402E electric loco with black lettered brass plates that have a red trim around edges, a red letter E rubber-stamped on the doors and dual super motors, 419 baggage/Pullman car, 418 Pullman and a 490 observation. The cars have maroon inserts, wood grained doors, nickel journals and NEW YORK CENTRAL LINES stamped above the windows. The set is C6. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert.
- **2019** Lionel prewar standard gauge 441 weighing station with ten original weights, green base, cream walls, maroon crackle roof, terra cotta widow frames and brass plate painted red in worn OB. The station is C7.
- 2020 Lionel prewar standard gauge desirable Coal Train set no. 340E, circa 1929 containing; 318 black electric loco with red lettered brass plates, three 516 red hoppers all with gold rubber-stamped lettering that has capacity data on the sides and a 517 red caboose with black roof and orange window inserts. The cars have brass trim and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled and is C7-8. The cars have some minor nicks, otherwise are C8.
- **2021** Lionel prewar 45N automatic gateman with aluminum painted pole, brass cross buck and nickel finial in OB, C7-8. One flap is detached from the OB. The label on the box is fully intact.
- 2022 Lionel prewar standard gauge maroon passenger set no. 343, the scarce version with ILLINOIS CENTRAL stamped above the car windows. The set includes 380 electric loco with black lettered brass plates, 320 baggage, two 319 Pullmans and a 320 observation. The cars have Mojave inserts and nickel journals. The baggage has dark green doors and the other cars have wood grain doors. The loco has been rewheeled and is C6. The cars are C6-7.
- 2023 Lionel prewar standard gauge 318 pea green electric loco with black lettered brass plates and brass trim in OB. Loco has scratch on one side, C6. OB is missing one interior flap.
- **2024** Lionel prewar standard gauge no. 90 flag pole with grass plot in OB, C6. The flag has some tears. The OB has most flaps attached.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge two-tone green Transcontinental Limited State Set no. 411E, circa 1929 all in OBs including; 381E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 412 California Pullman, 413 Colorado Pullman, 414 Illinois Pullman and a 416 New York observation. The cars have apple green window inserts and die-cast journals. The interiors in all of the cars are original and complete. The loco has been rewheeled. This is a clean original matched State set, C7. All of the individual OBs are correctly marked SPEC. GREEN. OBs have all flaps attached except for the 413 which is missing all of the exterior flaps.
- 2026 Lionel prewar standard gauge 511 medium green lumber flatcar with load, silver rubber-stamping and all nickel trim and journals in OB, C8. The OB is a brick and is bright and clean.



- 2027 Lionel prewar standard gauge 512 45N green gondola with six wooden barrels and all nickel trim and journals in OB, C8. The OB is missing two interior flaps and coupler flaps.
- 2028 Lionel prewar standard gauge 513 cream cattle car with maroon roof and door guides all nickel trim and journals, C6-7.
- 2029 Lionel prewar standard gauge 514 yellow boxcar with brown roof and door guides and all nickel trim and journals in OB, C8. The OB is missing one interior flap and has one coupler flap detached but included.
- 2030 Lionel prewar standard gauge 514R white refrigerator car with a light blue roof and all nickel trim and journals in OB. The couplers have light surface corrosion, otherwise the car is C8. The OB is missing interior flaps on one end and has tape repair.
- **2031** Lionel prewar standard gauge 515 aluminum Sunoco tank with all nickel trim and journals. Both decals are intact. The tank is C8.
- **2032** Lionel prewar standard gauge 515 orange Shell tank with all nickel trim and journals in OB. Both decals are fully intact, C8. The OB is missing one coupler flap.
- 2033 Lionel prewar standard gauge 516 red hopper with all nickel trim and journals in OB, C8. The OB has all flaps, with one exterior flap detached but included.
- **2034** Lionel prewar standard gauge 520 floodlight car with green base and all nickel trim and journals in OB, C8. The OB shows wear.
- **2035** Lionel prewar standard gauge 517 red caboose with all nickel trim and journals in a worn OB. The frame has some minor nicks on the frame, otherwise caboose is C8.
- 2036 Lionel prewar standard gauge Pennsylvania Limited Stephen Girard green passenger set no. 378E, circa 1934 in individual OBs including; 392E black steam loco with brass and copper trim, 384T harder to find crackle black tender with brass trim and copper journals, 424 Liberty Bell Pullman, 425 Stephen Girard Pullman and a 426 Coral Isle observation. The cars have cream window inserts and brass journals. The set is C7. The engine and tender OBs have original cardboard inserts. The OBs are complete with all flaps except for the 425 which is missing one end flap.
- 2037 Lionel prewar standard gauge set box only for the Stephen Girard passenger set no. 378E, circa 1934 containing the 392E loco, 384T tender, 424 Pullman, 425 Pullman and 426 observation. The set box is complete with all flaps, is stained and has label fully intact.
- 2038 Lionel prewar standard gauge olive green passenger set no. 347 in individual OBs and set box. The set contains an 8 electric loco with black lettered brass plates, 337 Pullman and a 338 observation. The cars have red inserts and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled. The roof on the observation car has two dents. The set is C7-8. The individual OBs are clean with all flaps attached. The set box has no split corners and has both labels intact.
- 2039 Lionel prewar standard gauge 332 olive green baggage with red inserts and doors and nickel journals in OB. The baggage car was available for separate sale purchase only. Frank had this baggage included with the set that is listed in Lot 38. The car is C7-8. The OB has all flaps attached.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge 9-U Bild-A-Loco outfit in original yellow kit box. The set contains an orange 9-U loco which has a weighted frame and has been assembled, eight curve track sections, Bild-A-Loco motor no. 2, frame, gears, screwdriver, wires, connecting ties and a worn original instruction sheet. The kit is C7. The OB is stained and has labels mostly intact with frayed edges.
- 2041 Lionel prewar standard gauge 94 high tension tower with terra cotta base, gunmetal tower and brass plate in a stained OB. All six porcelain insulators are original and intact. The tower is C7-8. The OB has all flaps attached and is stained.



- **2042** Lionel prewar standard gauge 94 high tension tower with aluminum tower, red base and nickel plate. All six porcelain insulators are original and intact. Tower is C7-8.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge gray passenger set no. 352E, circa 1926-27 in individual OBs and set box containing; 10E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 332 baggage, 339 Pullman and a 341 observation. The cars have maroon inserts, nickel journals and have THE LIONEL LINES stamped above the windows. Set is C7. The OBs have all flaps attached. The set box has three split corners and both labels are intact.
- 2044 Lionel prewar standard gauge 126 Lionelville station with green base, mustard walls and chimneys, red roof, window inserts and doors, white window and door frames and brass plates in OB, C6. The OB is complete with all flaps.
- 2045 Lionel prewar standard gauge Macys Special two-tone brown passenger set no. 387E, circa 1930 in individual OBs and set box. The set contains 384E black steam loco with brass and copper trim, red lettered brass plates and green striping, 384T tender with brass trim, nickel journals and green striping, 332 baggage, 339 Pullman and a 341 observation. The cars have cream inserts and nickel journals. The engine is C7. The tender and passenger cars are C7-8. All of the passenger car OBs are correctly stamped BROWN MS which stands for Macys Special. Boxes with this stamping are very difficult to find. The individual OBs have all flaps attached. The set box has a R.H. Macy & Co. label below the Lionel label.
- **2046** Lionel prewar standard gauge no. 2 red Bild-A-Motor with instruction sheet in OB, C8. The box has no split corners and has label mostly intact.
- 2047 Lionel prewar standard gauge Washington Special red passenger set no. 367W in individual OBs except for the 1767 which is missing. This set is the later version and contains; 385E gunmetal steam loco with all nickel trim, painted boiler bands and black wheels, 385W tender with nickel trim and journals, 1767 baggage, 1766 Pullman and a 1768 observation. The cars are red with maroon roofs, aluminum inserts and nickel journals. The tender casting is solid and straight however does have some paint flaking in the front. Set is C7-8. Loco OB has all original cardboard. Loco and tender OBs are complete with all flaps attached. Each car OB is missing one exterior flap.
- 2048 Lionel prewar standard gauge scarce 10 peacock electric loco with orange hatches and stripe, dark green frame and red lettered brass plates in OB. The loco has a Lionel Super Motor. Loco is C6. The OB has all flaps attached.
- 2049 Lionel prewar 83 die-cast traffic and crossing signal with red base, cream box and white head in a worn OB, C7-8.
- 2050 Lionel prewar standard gauge Blue Comet passenger set no. 396E, circa 1931-32 in individual OBs except for the tender. This set contains; 400E steam loco with white number boards that have red lettering and red spoked wheels, 400T tender with black lettered brass plates, 420 Faye Pullman, 421 Westphal Pullman and a 422 Tempel observation. The loco and tender have brass and copper trim. The tender and cars have die-cast journals. A whistle was added to the tender. This was done after production because the whistle was not produced until 1935 and this set is from 1931-32. In discussions with knowledgeable collectors and past sales of these tenders it is believed that Lionel added the whistle for their customers. This is very high quality original Blue Comet set. This set is a C8 except for a couple of minor scratches. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert. The boxes have all flaps attached. The 420 OB has one area of damage on the side.
- 2051 Lionel prewar 87 die-cast railroad crossing signal with green base, cream box and white head in OB. The die-cast body has some hairline cracks but is still intact. Signal is C7-8. The OB is missing all flaps on one end.
- 2052 Lionel prewar standard gauge two-tone brown Baby State set no. 342E in individual OBs including; 318E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 310 baggage, 309 Pullman and a 312 observation. The cars have cream inserts and copper journals. The set is C7-8. The loco OB is stamped BROWN and the car boxes are stamped BROWN IVORY. All of the boxes are clean and have all flaps attached.
- 2053 Lionel prewar standard gauge 120L illuminated tunnel in OB. The tunnel does have a couple of paint flakes on the ends. The colors on the tunnel are very vibrant. Tunnel is C7-8. The OB has label intact but has darkened, is brittle and missing flaps on one end.



- 2054 Lionel prewar standard gauge pea green Macys Special no. 2 passenger set in individual OBs and set box, circa 1932. The set contains an 8E electric loco with cream inserts and red lettered brass plates, two 337 Pullmans and a 338 observation with a Macy Special drumhead on the end railing. The cars have cream inserts and nickel journals. The set is C7-8. The individual OBs are all stamped L. GREEN are clean and have all flaps attached. Set box is stamped SPECIAL 2, has no split corners and both labels are intact. This is a clean matched original set.
- **2055** Lionel prewar standard gauge 63 die-cast aluminum lamp post. The post has a slight bend and is C6-7.
- 2056 Lionel prewar standard gauge Mojave passenger set no. 352, circa 1925 including; 10 electric loco with black lettered brass plates, two 337 Pullmans and a 338 observation. The cars have maroon inserts and doors, nickel journals and NEW YORK CENTRAL LINES stamped above the windows. The loco has been rewheeled. The set is C6.
- **2057** Lionel prewar standard gauge 45N green 280 girder bridge with black lettered nickel plates, C7.
- 2058 Lionel prewar standard gauge gunmetal 400E steam loco and 400W tender circa 1934 with OB for loco. The loco has copper trim and boiler bands, brass L plates under the windows, red spoked wheels, three position E unit and has a chugger. The tender has brass and copper trim, black lettered brass plates and brass journals. The steam chests on the loco have some paint nicks. The rest of loco is C7-8. The trucks and couplers on the tender have surface corrosion. Tender is C7. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert and is missing three flaps on one end.
- **2059** Lionel prewar standard gauge 212 gray gondola, circa 1926 with six wooden barrels, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals, C7.
- 2060 Lionel prewar standard gauge 212 maroon gondola with six wooden barrels, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB, C8. The OB is correctly marked WINE, has paste on label and all flaps are attached.
- 2061 Lionel prewar standard gauge 208 gray tool box with gold rubber-stamping containing six nickel-plated cast iron tools, C7 -8.
- 2062 Lionel prewar standard gauge 213 Mojave cattle car with maroon roof and door guides, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB. The door guides have some paint nicks, otherwise the car is C8. The OB is complete with all flaps but shows some wear.
- 2063 Lionel prewar standard gauge 213 terra cotta cattle car with pea green roof and door guides, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB, C6. The OB is complete with all flaps and has a paste on label fully intact.
- 2064 Lionel prewar standard gauge 214 terra cotta boxcar with dark green roof and door guides, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals, C7-8.
- 2065 Lionel prewar standard gauge 214 cream boxcar with orange roof and door guides, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB, C7-8. The OB has all flaps attached.
- 2066 Lionel prewar standard gauge 214R ivory refrigerator car with peacock roof, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals. The car has some minor paint nicks and is C7-8.
- 2067 Lionel prewar standard gauge 215 pea green tank with red lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB. The frame has a scratch, otherwise the tanks is C8. The OB is missing two interior flaps and one exterior flap is detached.
- 2068 Lionel prewar standard gauge 216 dark green hopper with red lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB. Hopper has a couple of tiny nicks, otherwise is C8. The OB is complete with all flaps and has paste on label.
- 2069 Lionel prewar standard gauge 218 Mojave dump, the version with brass ends, black lettered brass plates, two brass knobs and nickel journals in OB, C8. The OB has all flaps attached.



- 2070 Lionel prewar standard gauge 219 crane car with peacock cab, dark green roof, red boom, black lettered brass plates, brass knobs and trim and nickel journals in OB. This is an unusual version with the red windows on the cab in the front section of the cab closest to the boom. Crane is C7. The OB is complete with all flaps and has a paste on label.
- 2071 Lionel prewar standard gauge 205 set of three LCL merchandise containers in a worn OB. One of the containers is missing the bracket for the handle and all containers are missing the chains. The containers are C7.
- 2072 Lionel prewar standard gauge 220 searchlight car with terra cotta base, brass trim and lamp housings and nickel journals in OB, C6. The OB has all flaps attached.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge 217 red caboose with peacock roof, black lettered brass plates, brass trim and nickel journals in OB. The ribs on the roof and cupola have paint rubs, otherwise caboose is C8. The OB has all flaps attached.
- 2074 Lionel prewar standard gauge 124 Lionel City station with Mojave base, terra cotta walls, cream trim, pea green roof and windows, red doors, brass plates and light fixtures in a worn OB, C8.
- 2075 Lionel prewar standard gauge Pennsylvania Limited Stephen Girard passenger set no. 378W, circa 1936-39 in individual OBs and set box. The set contains a 392E gunmetal steam loco, 392W tender, 424 Liberty Bell Pullman, 425 Stephen Girard Pullman and a Coral Isle 426 observation car with a PRR drumhead on the end railing. The loco and tender have all nickel trim. The cars have nickel trim and brass plates. This is a high quality original set which has some box rubs, otherwise is C8. The individual OBs are complete with all flaps attached. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert. The set box has been opened from the bottom and has brown tape repair. The label is fully intact.
- **2076** Lionel prewar standard gauge 59 harder to find red lamp post, C7-8.
- 2077 Lionel prewar standard gauge very scarce pea green passenger set no. 394E, circa 1930 in individual OBs. The set contains 390E black steam loco with brass and copper trim, 390T tender with brass trim and nickel journals, 310 baggage with dark green doors, 309 Pullman and a 312 observation. The loco and tender both have orange stripes. The cars have orange inserts and nickel journals. The loco is C6-7. The tender and cars are C7-8. The loco OB Is missing one interior flap. The car boxes are correctly stamped L. GREEN. The boxes are clean and have all flaps attached.
- **2078** Lionel prewar standard gauge 436 power station with Mojave base, terra cotta walls, pea green skylight, door and window frames, cream window inserts and roof cornice, red doors and chimney and brass plates, C6-7.
- 2079 Lionel prewar standard gauge red passenger set no. 347, circa 1930-32 in individual OBs and set box containing; 8 electric loco with black lettered brass plates, cream inserts and stripe, 337 Pullman and a 339 observation. The cars have cream inserts and nickel journals. The observation car has a decal R at the end of the roof which we are unable to determine its authenticity. Set is C6. The individual OBs have all flaps attached. The set box has all corners repaired and both labels intact.
- 2080 Lionel prewar standard gauge desirable 444 roundhouse. The roundhouse is complete with all windows, doors and both skylights. Overall the paint on the roundhouse is very clean with some minor nicks. The roundhouse is C7-8.
- **2081** Lionel prewar standard gauge 200 turntable scarce version with black base, red rotating disk and black lettered brass plate, C6.
- 2082 Lionel prewar standard gauge dark green passenger set no. 348E, circa 1926-28 containing; 380E electric loco with additional weights and red lettered brass plates, 429 Pullman/baggage in a worn OB, 428 Pullman and a 430 observation. The cars have maroon inserts and nickel journals. Set is C6.
- 2083 Lionel prewar standard gauge 155 freight shed with yellow base, terra cotta floor, pea green posts, maroon roof with yellow underside, brass finials and black lettered plates, C7.



- 2084 Lionel prewar standard gauge 163 freight station set with two 157 red hand trucks, 161 45N green baggage truck and a 162 dump truck with orange frame and peacock bin in yellow OB with white label, C7. The yellow OB shows some wear on the top and label is intact.
- 2085 Lionel prewar standard gauge Mojave passenger set no. 409E, circa 1927-28 in individual OBs and set box. The set contains a 408E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 419 Pullman/baggage, 418 Pullman, 431 dining car and a 490 observation car. The cars have orange inserts, maroon doors and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled. The paint on this set is very bright and clean. The roof on the loco has two scratches, otherwise the set is C8. This is very high quality matched original set. The 408E OB has two original cardboard inserts. The individual OBs are clean and have all flaps attached. The set box is complete with all flaps that have tape repair. Both labels are intact.
- **2086** Lionel prewar standard gauge 99N train control block signal with red die-cast base, aluminum pole, red ladder and nickel plate, C7.
- 2087 Lionel prewar standard gauge scarce olive green Macys Special passenger set including; 10E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 332 baggage, 337 Pullman and a 338 observation with a black lettered brass Macys Special oval plate on the observation railing. The cars have red inserts and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled. The loco and baggage are C6. The Pullman and observation cars are C7. This is a very unusual set and this is the first example of an olive green loco that we have seen.
- 2088 Lionel prewar standard gauge 127 Lioneltown station with a mustard base, white walls and chimneys, 45N green door and window frames, cream windows and doors, red roof and nickel plates in OB. One end has some paint flaking around windows, otherwise station is C7-8. The OB is complete with all flaps.
- **2089** Lionel prewar standard gauge 79 aluminum flashing highway signal with aluminum cross arms, black lettered nickel Railroad Crossing cross buck and nickel finial, C7.
- 2090 Lionel prewar standard gauge apple green passenger set no. 432E, circa 1931-32 in individual OBs. One column on one side has paint touch up. The rest of the station is C7. The OB is missing one interior flap. The label is fully intact.
- 2257 Lionel prewar standard gauge 1835E black steam loco with nickel trim, black wheels, painted boiler bands and domes, brass LL plates under the windows and an 1835T die-cast tender with black and nickel plates, nickel trim and journals both in OBs. Except for some minor nicks on the cowcatcher the loco is C8. The tender has surface corrosion on the wheels, axles, draw bar and coupler. The die-cast tender body is solid and intact, C7. The OBs have all flaps attached.
- **2258** Lionel prewar standard gauge scarce two 339 peacock Pullmans with dark green roofs, nickel steps, nickel journals, orange inserts and doors in OBs. The roofs on the cars are C7. - Lionel prewar standard gauge unusual and hard to find promotional dark green passenger set no. 349, circa 1929 including; 9 Bild-A-Loco electric loco with reverse knob and black lettered brass plates, 429 Pullman/Baggage car, 428 Pullman car, 430 observation. The cars have orange inserts, maroon doors and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled. The set is C7. The cars are in OBs which are correctly stamped D.GREEN. OBs are clean and have all flaps attached.
- 2264 Lionel prewar standard gauge 94 high tension tower with terra cotta base, gunmetal tower and brass plate. All six porcelain insulators are original and intact. The tower is C6-7.
- 2265 Lionel prewar standard gauge pea green passenger set no. 342E, circa 1927-28 in individual OBs. The set contains a 318E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, 310 baggage with dark green doors, 309 Pullman and a 312 observation. The 309 and 312 cars have orange doors. All cars have orange inserts and nickel journals. The loco has been rewheeled and has a large scratch on the roof. The 312 observation car has a dent in the roof. Set is C7-8. The OBs have all flaps attached.
- 2266 Lionel prewar standard gauge 136 Lionelville station with automatic train control, 45N green base, mustard walls and chimneys, red roof, doors and ticket windows, white door frames and window inserts and nickel plates, C5-6.
- 2267 Lionel prewar standard gauge rare, one of a kind greenish gray paint sample of the passenger set no. 409E. The factory production of this set was Mojave or apple green from 1927-29. - Lionel prewar standard gauge 140L lighted 90-degree curve tunnel, hand painted steel construction with seven chalet-style houses, waterfall passing under the fence and a snow-capped mountain top. This is the version with yellow painted portals. The paint on the tunnel is bright and clean with some paint flaking. Tunnel is C7.



- Lionel prewar standard gauge Sears Department Store red passenger set no. 5196, circa 1931 in individual OBs. The set consists of an 8E electric loco with red lettered brass plates, cream inserts and striping, two 337 Pullmans and a 338 observation. The cars have cream inserts and doors, brass steps and nickel journals. Set is C7. The OBs have all flaps attached, except for the loco OB which is missing two flaps.
- 2273 Lionel prewar standard gauge 102 bridge set consisting of two 104 pea green and cream bridge center spans and one pair of 100 approaches in OB. The paint on the bridge spans and approaches is bright and clean. The set is C7. The OB has all flaps attached and label is intact.
- 2274 Lionel prewar standard gauge Mojave passenger set no. 403E in individual OBs including; 402E electric loco with red lettered brass plates that have a red trim around edges and dual super motors, 419 baggage/Pullman car, 418 Pullman and a 490 observation. The cars have maroon inserts and doors and nickel journals. The loco has black replacement wheels. The loco body is separated on one corner. Loco is C6. The cars are C7. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert. The OBs are complete but show wear.
- **2275** Lionel prewar standard gauge very scarce late version of a 437 switch signal tower with red base, cream lower and upper walls, cream chimney, brown band between floors, orange roof, green windows and red doors. Tower is C6-7.
- **2276** Lionel prewar standard gauge 380E maroon electric loco with black lettered brass plates, red E stamped on the doors and die-cast headlights, C6-7.
- 2277 Lionel prewar standard gauge 300 Hell Gate bridge with terra cotta base, cream towers, apple green sides, black lettered brass plates and brass railings in OB, C7. The OB is worn and is missing all flaps on one end.

- 2280 Lionel prewar standard gauge 392E gunmetal steam loco with nickel trim, brass and red LL plates under the windows and a 392W tender with nickel trim, red and nickel plates, nickel journals and brass L plate on the back of the tender in individual OBs. The paint and trim on the loco and tender are bright and clean. Loco and tender are C8. The loco OB has an original cardboard insert. The tender OB has an original cardboard insert. Both OBs have all flaps attached.
- 2281 Lionel prewar standard gauge two-tone Blue Comet passenger cars with black lettered brass plates, nickel trim and journals including; 420 Faye Pullman, 421 Westphal Pullman and a 422 Tempel observation with nickel end railing. - **2286** Lionel prewar standard gauge 408E apple green electric loco with red lettered brass plates and dual Super Motors. The wheels on the loco are starting to disintegrate. The loco is C7.
- 2287 Lionel prewar standard gauge desirable 444 roundhouse. The roundhouse is complete with all windows, doors and both skylights. The roof on the lower section of the roundhouse has some scratches and a small area on the lower section of the roof has a rough paint finish. The inside floor of the roundhouse has surface corrosion. The roundhouse is C5.
- **2288** Lionel prewar standard gauge no. 8 electric loco with an Ives body painted Ives Cadet blue. The loco has black lettered Lionel brass plates, brass trim and cream inserts. The loco has a dent in the roof and is C6.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge unusual leftover Ives 341 observation car with a Lionel decal over the Ives decal that reads THE LIONEL RAILWAY LINES. The car is peacock with dark green roof, orange inserts and nickel journals, C5.

- 2291 Lionel prewar standard gauge 99 die-cast train control block signal with black base, red ladder, ivory pole and brass plate. The signal has been rewired. The block signal is C7.
- Lionel prewar standard gauge olive green passenger set in individual OBs containing; 8 electric loco with black lettered brass plates, two 337 Pullmans and a 338 observation. The cars have maroon inserts and doors and nickel journals. The olive green 8 set no. 347 was cataloged with one 337 Pullman. With two 337 Pullmans it could be a department store special set no. 360 Special no. 2. Without the original set box we are unable to determine the exact set number. The loco has been rewheeled. The set is C6. The OBs show some wear.
- 2293 Lionel prewar standard gauge 812T tool set in OB. The set contains three nickel-plated cast iron tools including; shovel, pick and sledge hammer. The tools are C8. The OB is clean and square with all flaps attached.
- **2294** Lionel prewar standard gauge two no. 53 ivory lamp posts, C7.
- 2295 Lionel prewar standard gauge 380 maroon electric loco with black lettered brass plates and nickel strap headlights. One of the headlights is detached but included. Loco is C5.
- 2296 Lionel prewar standard gauge two orange 57 lamp posts with street names, one with Fifth Avenue, 21st Street, Broadway and 42nd Street and one with Broadway and 21st Street. The lamp post with four street names is missing a terminal and the plastic insert sign is bent. The lamp post is C5. The other lamp post is C6.
- **2297** Lionel prewar standard gauge 392W gunmetal tender in OB. The tender has red and nickel plates, a brass L plate on the back of the tender, nickel trim and journals, C8. The OB is missing one flap.

This set contained a 10E Peacock electric loco, 511 dark green flatcar, 512 peacock gondola, 513 orange cattle car with pea green roof, 514 cream boxcar with orange roof and a 517 pea green caboose with red roof. The loco OB has all flaps attached. The car boxes are missing some flaps. The set box is stamped PEACOCK BLUE below the label which is fully intact. The set box has no split corners.
- 2303 Lionel prewar standard gauge original set box only for passenger set no. 350, circa 1925-26. The set contained an 8 electric loco, 35 Pullman and 36 observation. Also including are two original individual OBs only for the 35 and 36 passenger cars. The set box and individual OBs are worn.
- 2304 Lionel prewar standard gauge original master carton only for a 400E steam loco and tender. The master carton is missing one exterior flap, has moisture damage and the label is fully intact. Also included is an original individual 400E steam loco box. The individual OB has all flaps attached, has moisture damage and is stained.
- **2305** Lionel prewar standard gauge original master carton only for a 385E steam loco and tender. The box has all flaps attached with flaps worn on one end. The label is fully intact.
- 2306 Lionel prewar standard gauge original mater carton for a 390E loco and tender. The master carton box has no split corners and both labels are fully intact. Also included are the original individual OBs for the 390E black loco and 390T black tender. The individual OBs have all flaps attached.
