Ives prewar O gauge 1100 black 0-4-0 cast iron steam loco with gold and red painted trim and two boiler bands. The loco has been restored.



2002

Ives prewar O gauge no. 3217 black 0-4-0 cast iron electric loco with raised red lettering and red painted trim. The loco has been restored.



2003

Ives prewar O gauge two 306 mottled gray electric street lamps, C6.



2004

Ives prewar O gauge no. 30 dark olive green 0-4-0 clockwork N.Y.C. and H. R. electric loco with cast iron frame and gold rubber-stamping. The engine is C6.



2005

Ives prewar O gauge The Blue Racer passenger set no. 420, circa 1928. The set contains the following; 3260 electric loco with brass and black trim and a die-cast frame, 133 Parlor car and a 134 observation car. The passenger cars have brass trim and window inserts. The set is C6.



2006

Ives prewar O gauge no. 201-3 lithographed passenger station with gray base that has one-inch square embossed blocks, dark green embossed roof and light fixtures on each end of the station, C6. Also included is an Ives no. 89 water tank with an orange tank, C6-7.



2007

Ives prewar O gauge lithographed freight set no. 1615, circa 1932. The set contains the following; 258 black steam 2-4-0 loco with brass and copper trim and orange striping, 1663T eight-wheel Ives Lines tender with brass and copper trim and copper journals, 1707 brown gondola, 1708 green stock car with tan doors and door guides, 1709 green boxcar with blue roof, orange doors and door guides, 1712 red caboose with maroon roof. The eight-wheel freight cars have copper journals. The cowcatcher on the loco is mostly broken off and is C6. The tender and boxcar are C7. The gondola and stock car are C6 and the caboose is C5.

Ives prewar O gauge orange eight-wheel passenger cars with black roofs and vestibules, except for the observation car which has a brass vestibule, brass plates and journals including; two no. 143 Parlor cars and a 142 observation car. The cars all have Pullman plates above the windows. The roofs on the 142 cars have been repainted and the 143 roof has paint touch up. The car bodies are C6.

Ives prewar O gauge no. 119 lithographed Suburban Station platform with two posts, circa 1905-06. The station has two plates attached by rivets on the roof. The station is C6.

The four-wheel passenger cars have black roofs with silver clerestories and the frames have red lithographed spring detail. The set is C6.





Ives prewar O or 1 gauge desirable 122 lithographed station with glass domed platform which consists of a 116 lithographed Grand Central Station with a V-shaped bay and a 121 platform. The station has cast iron window and door frames and chimney tops. The dome consists of eight glass panels, four green and four clear. The 121 platform is missing both benches, has three restored wooden posts and is longer than the station base. The lithographing on the station base and platform base do not match. The station and dome are C6.




